**Community Eggxtravaganza Event to Feature Family Activities and Fentanyl Awareness Education**

**NORFOLK, VA** — Families across Hampton Roads are invited to attend the Eggxtravaganza Hunt on Saturday, May 9, 2026, from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM at Norview Community Center (6380 Sewells Point Rd., Norfolk, VA).

This free, family-centered community event will include an egg hunt, games, food, raffles, and giveaways designed to bring families together in a safe and engaging environment.

As part of the event, Men and Women of Vision (MWoV) will provide a fentanyl awareness and safety education workshop, offering families and youth practical information about exposure risks and prevention.

“Many families are surprised by how little they know about fentanyl exposure risks,” said representatives from Men and Women of Vision. “Our goal is to provide clear, practical information that helps parents and young people recognize potential dangers and make safer choices.” The workshop is designed to provide practical, easy-to-understand information that families can immediately apply in real-world situations.

The event is presented by Jewel Barber in partnership with community organizations, including *Men and Women of Vision*, and local civic groups supporting family engagement and community wellness.

Event activities will include:

- Community egg hunt
- Games and family activities
- Food and refreshments
- Raffles and giveaways
- Fentanyl awareness and safety education resources
