All work operates under board-approved guidelines, documented processes, and formal partnerships. This ensures that programs are not only effective, but compliant, transparent, and sustainable.

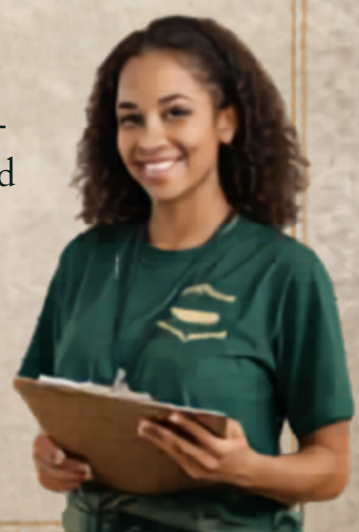
